

Summer Session 1: June 12 – June 30

Summer Session 2: July 10 – July 28

Summer School classes are available from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm and the Extension Program is open from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm (closed 8:00 – 11:30 am).

- **Registration and Fees**

- Students should enroll in classes based on their grade level for the upcoming school year. Please sign up online or fill out a registration form. You must use one registration form for each child you are enrolling.
- The non-refundable registration fee must accompany registration form.
- Prices are for the entire three week session, and no discounts will be given for time missed due to vacation or other reasons.
- No refunds will be given for dropped classes after June 13, 2016. All schedules are final. Schedules cannot be changed after the first day of the session.
- **The entire balance of the total tuition and fees is due on or before the Friday before the start of the session.**

- **Attendance**

- Students are expected to attend summer school classes daily. If time must be missed, please inform the director or teacher.

- **Recess and Lunch**

- Students should have a snack if they will be on campus during recess (9:30 -10:00). A SNACK SHACK will be available at recess for students to purchase snacks (prices range from \$0.50 to \$1.00 per item).
- Students must have a lunch if they will be on campus during the lunch period (11:40 - 12:30).
- A fun lunch will be available to order each week. See calendar posted in Extension.

Summer School Tuition

Classes run Monday through Friday. Each price is for the entire three-week session.

Morning Session (3 ½ hours per day). \$ 285.00 per session

Afternoon Class (70 min per day). \$ 99.00 per session

Class Descriptions

Minimum registration is required to offer each course. Classes may be canceled or combined if minimum registration is not met. Courses that fill to capacity will be closed, so register early!

Students who are on campus between the hours of 8:00 and 11:30 am must be enrolled in the morning session. Students on campus after lunch may be enrolled in classes or in the Extension program.

All classes run Monday through Friday. All schedules are final and cannot be changed after the first day of classes for the session.

Wednesday afternoons will involve a special summer camp. Students in afternoon classes and Extension will participate in a variety of fun activities related to the week's theme. Calendar with weekly themes, fun lunch menu, and other events will be available on first day of school.

Morning Academic Sessions

Grades: PreK-8

These grade-level based classes will focus mainly on math, reading, and writing. Other subject matter and fun activities will be incorporated throughout the day. Students will have an opportunity to become acquainted with their teachers, classmates, and new classroom through play and fun learning experiences.

Afternoon Classes

Cartooning

Grades: K-8

Supply fee: \$20

Required Supplies: sketch pad

Beginning and intermediate artists will enjoy this amazing drawing class. Students will learn to draw characters of all kinds and learn techniques in color and shading. Lovers of Disney, Marvel, Anime, and more will love the fun this class has to offer.

Computer Skills & Gaming

Grades: 2-8

This class will focus on learning skills in Microsoft Office, building a website, typing skills, and much more. Students will use Chromebooks and iPads as they play fun, academic games and will even complete a digital project.

Edible Sensations

Grades: K-8

Supply fee: \$20

Required Supplies: apron (optional)

Impress your family and friends with delicious, sensational creations made from all things edible. Students will design and create “edible sensations” by thinking like an engineer. If you love building and snacking, this is the class for you!

Caution: this class is not recommended for students with severe allergies

Lego Engineering

Grades: K-8

This class is perfect for students who love to build, design, and create with Legos. Students will complete individual and team challenges in this class that will challenge them to think critically and creatively!

Magician's Club

Grades: 2-8 Supply fee: \$20

Do you believe in Magic? This class is for true believers only. Students will learn the trade of Magicians and turn ordinary objects into astonishing surprises. Students will learn plenty of tricks to impress!

Master Chess

Grades: 2-8 Supply fee: \$10

Students will learn the ins and outs to Chess. They will be masters of their craft. Chess is a valuable educational tool that helps teach important lessons including problem solving, critical thinking, sportsmanship, patience and goal setting -- plus, it is fun!

Reader's Theater- Summer Production

Grades: 1-8 Supply fee: \$20

Students will practice their reading skills as they rehearse and perform a Reader's Summer Theater production run by our very own, Mrs. Giffard! Students will be involved in the writing process, as well as creating sets, rehearsing lines, and preparing for a performance.

Sports Camp

Grades: 1-8 *students should wear athletic clothing, athletic shoes, and sunscreen

Students enrolled in this class will play a variety of team sports including soccer, basketball, volleyball, baseball, kickball, and more. Students will learn the fundamentals of each sport while perfecting technical skills.

Ultimate Frisbee

Grades: 3-8 Supply fee: \$10

This course is both an introduction to the fundamental skills and strategies of organized Ultimate Disc and a course designed to further develop individual skills for the beginning to intermediate player. Students will participate in a wide variety of drills and exercises to learn and improve their Ultimate Disc skills.

- **Tuition and Fees**
 - Tuition rates are based on the hours a child spends in Extension daily. No charges are accrued during recess and lunch.
 - Tuition is due every Friday. A student may not stay in Extension if the previous balance is not paid.

- **General Information**
 - All students must be signed in and out of Extension daily by an authorized adult.
 - Students who are enrolled in Extension will be served an afternoon snack daily at 3:30 pm.

- **Important:** students who remain in Extension after 6:00 pm will be charged \$2.00 per minute per child.
