Summer School classes are available from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm and the Summer Extension Program is open from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm (closed 8:00 – 11:30 am). Summer Extension will be available June 4 - 29; July 9 - August 10. The campus will be closed July 2 - July 6.

Registration and Fees

Students should enroll in classes based on their grade level for the upcoming school year. Please sign up online or fill out a registration form.

You must use one registration form for each child you are enrolling.

The non-refundable registration fee must accompany registration form.

Prices are for the entire three week session, and no discounts will be given for time missed due to vacation or other reasons.

No refunds will be given for dropped classes after June 13, 2018. All schedules are final. Schedules cannot be changed after the first day of the session.

The entire balance of the total tuition and fees is due on or before the Friday before the start of the session.

Attendance

Students are expected to attend summer school classes daily. If time must be missed, please inform the director or teacher.

Recess and Lunch

Students should have a snack if they will be on campus during recess (9:30 -10:00). A SNACK SHACK will be available at recess for students to purchase snacks (prices range from \$0.25 to \$1.00 per item).

Students must have a lunch if they will be on campus during the lunch period (11:40 - 12:30). Hot Lunch is available on Fridays with preorder.

Class Descriptions

Minimum registration is required to offer each course. Classes may be canceled or combined if minimum registration is not met. Courses that fill to capacity will be closed, so register early!

Students who are on campus between the hours of 8:00 and 11:30 am must be enrolled in the morning session. Students on campus after lunch may be enrolled in classes or in the Extension program.

All classes run Monday through Friday. All schedules are final and cannot be changed after the first day of classes for the session.

Wednesday afternoons will involve "Water Wednesdays". Students in afternoon classes and Extension will participate in a variety of fun water activities.

Morning Academic Session

Grades: PreK-8

These grade-level based classes will focus mainly on math, reading, and writing. Other subject matter and fun activities will be incorporated throughout the day. Students will have an opportunity to become acquainted with their teachers, classmates, and new classroom through play and fun learning experiences. Entrance Exam and ACT Prep will be focused in grades 5-8

Afternoon Classes

Adventures in Art

Grades: K-8

Do you like working with clay? Do you want to create things that you normally don't create during the average school year? Then this course is for you! In this course students will be working with 2-D and 3-D mediums. Not only will you be drawing, coloring and painting, you will be working with the wonders of clay and creating from every day objects that are treasured or trashed. Let your creativeness shine this summer!

Choral Choir

Grades K-8

If you love music and wish to explore singing with friends in an informal setting, choral choir is for you! While students have fun learning to sing songs from many cultures, styles and periods, this beginning choral experience helps develop healthy vocal habits, musicianship skills and appropriate choir behavior.

Gross Science

Grades: K- 8

Fake puke, fake blood, fake snot! If you think this sounds like fun, then Gross Science is the class for you! Gross Science will give you an opportunity to conduct hands-on experiments and activities, most of which are based on stomach-turning topics! Please bring an apron, smock, or old T-shirt.

Afternoon Classes

Keyboard Camp

Grades: K-8

Keyboard Camp is a piano instruction method that teaches beginning piano skills. Students will learn to read and perform musical notation as they progress through the “ranks” of the Keyboard Camp piano book series. Students work at their own pace to achieve each rank, beginning with “Boot Camp” and culminating with “General.”

Lego Engineering

Grades: K-8

This class is perfect for students who love to build, design, and create with Legos. Students will complete individual and team challenges in this class that will challenge them to think critically and creatively!

Grades: K-8

Grades: K-8

Grades: K-8

Summer Extension

Tuition and Fees

Tuition rates are based on the hours a child spends in Extension daily. No charges are accrued during recess and lunch.

Tuition is due every Friday. A student may not stay in Extension if the previous balance is not paid.

General Information

All students must be signed in and out of Extension daily by an authorized adult.

Students who are enrolled in Extension will be served an afternoon snack daily at 3:30 pm.
