Dear Third through Eighth Grade Parents,

As partners in your child's education, it is important to ensure that they are prepared for each stop along their educational journey. One way to determine student preparedness is through assessment, and therefore we will be administering the ACT Aspire to your student on the week of May 4-8. ACT Aspire will be assessing your child's strengths in English (Language,) Writing, Reading, Math, and Science. All parents will receive comprehensive reports of their student's results. It is important to mention that this test is NOT and has nothing to do with the Smarter Balanced Common Core Test the California public schools are currently taking.

ACT Aspire will give us important information that will allow us to determine how your child is progressing at their current grade level, as well as along their overall path toward future college and career readiness. Test results will also provide students with a predicted ACT score. ACT Aspire will tell us which important skills, abilities and knowledge your student has now, and which ones still need to be learned in order to be successful in school in the future. Data from this assessment will allow teachers (including your child's teacher for the next school year,) principals, and parents to understand where your child is succeeding, as well as where extra help or academic focus is needed and will provide specific suggestions for improving skills.

Additionally to note, ACT Aspire is for students in grades 3-10 and has now replaced the PLAN (the traditional pre-ACT freshman/sophomore test). The data we receive from ACT Aspire during your child' elementary school years will build and lead directly to your child's junior year ACT test which is taken by more than 1.8 million high school students. ACT Aspire will be a vital assessment for grades 3-10 in the Catholic dioceses across the United States, and the Diocese of Sacramento is proud to be one of the first participants.


