



In addition, I would like to ask each OLA student to write a "Letter of Hope" to the children of Texas. These will let the children know that we are praying for them and their families.


Once I have collected everything, I will be able to ship all the items directly to St. Anthony's Parish staff, who will distribute them to all the children. They will also share the letters and prayers.
