Reason for leaving Geographic SELPA: **Our scholars must be driven from our school campus a school in the Anaheim Elementary School District. This results in an unnecessary loss of instructional time. This school's calendar and ours are not in alignment. This makes it difficult to have a consistency in services. Additionally, some of our scholars would be better served by a program in which the Speech Therapist and/or RSP Teacher could work with them in the classrooms (push-in vs. push-out). This is not possible under the current model. In our dialogues with other individuals involved in charter schools, the El Dorado SELPA has frequently been mentioned and comes with high recommendations. This option has been deeply discussed in our Teacher Think Tank Meetings, the Family and Staff Team (F.A.S.T.) Meetings, GOALS Academy Governance Committee Meetings, and in less formal dialogues with staff, parents, scholars, and community members. There is a strong consensus among all stakeholders that we must depart from the Anaheim Elementary School SELPA to pursue the El Dorado SELPA.**
