DESIGNATION OF LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT
OF CHARTER ALTERNATIVE PROGRAMS

August 1, 2016

The Superintendent of the El Dorado County Office of Education (Superintendent) has determined that it is in the best interests of the County Office of Education (EDCOE) and its students and staff that certain of the Superintendent's employees be designated and serve as EDCOE's law enforcement unit, as such term is defined in 34 C.F.R. section 99.8.

The Superintendent has designated the following employees of the Superintendent as EDCOE's law enforcement unit, as such term is defined in 34 C.F.R. section 99.8, during such time as they remain employees of the Superintendent:

The Superintendent has authorized EDCOE's law enforcement unit to perform the following functions with respect to EDCOE and its students and staff:

Enforce any local, State, or Federal law, or refer to appropriate authorities a matter for enforcement of any local, State, or Federal law against any individual or organization other than the agency or institution itself; and/or

Maintain the physical security and safety of the agency or institution.

The individuals listed above have been authorized to discharge the responsibilities and exercise the powers of the EDCOE law enforcement unit themselves or through one or more designees.

The Superintendent may remove or add to the individuals serving on EDCOE's law enforcement unit and/or modify the responsibilities, powers and authorities thereof for cause or convenience, at any time and in his/her sole discretion.
