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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The El Dorado County Special Education Local Plan Area is comprised of 15 LEAs within El Dorado County. Since its establishment in XXXX, these LEAs have advanced the belief of shared responsibility for all students with disabilities within the county. We have made decisions, worked together and allocated resources to ensure students, families and educators have the necessary support, services and programs. The SELPA Superintendents' Council has provided, on average, about one million dollars annually to fund regional programs, shared risk pools, and LEA programs and services. This amount does not include additional general fund dollars to operate programs.

The SELPA Superintendents' Council approved a new Allocation Plan on April 6, 2017. This Allocation Plan incorporates decisions made between 2015-2017. The 2017-18 school year will be the transition phase before being fully implemented in July 2018. The Allocation Plan establishes a framework for the core aspects of allocating special education funding. While this represents our collective best thinking to date, the document will continue to evolve in response to changes in state and federal funding as well as details to be uncovered through experience.
