Overnight Field Trip Proposal for

Rite of Passage Charter High School – Sierra Sage Academy

Proposed Trip:	USS Hornet Museum in Alameda, CA
Summary:	Ten students from the SSA Cadet Corps will be participating in this trip. Students will be touring the ship, learning about the history of the Hornet as well as the technology and engineering required to operate an aircraft carrier. Students will interact with military personnel, eat on the ship, and sleep in crew's quarters overnight while rotating through shifts for "night watch."
Dates/Details:	Leave Yerington, NV on the morning of September 7, 2018, arrive in Alameda at approximately 4:30 pm. Students and staff will board the ship at 5:30 pm, take part in a safety drill, have dinner in the crew's mess, and continue with presentations and tours. Students will wake up the morning of September 8, 2018, have breakfast in the mess and continue with educational program on the ship before leaving around the noon hour. Students will be back in Yerington in the evening of September 8th.
Grade Levels:	9-12
Transportation:	Rite of Passage is supporting this trip by providing vans and drivers to cover the cost of transportation as well as provide required supervision.
Cost:	The cost for the USS Hornet program is \$910 to cover registration of 6 students and 3 adults (ROP requires this adult/student ratio for trips).
Supervision:	Richard Alexander, Career Advisor (an EDCOE employee) and 2 Rite of Passage personnel.
