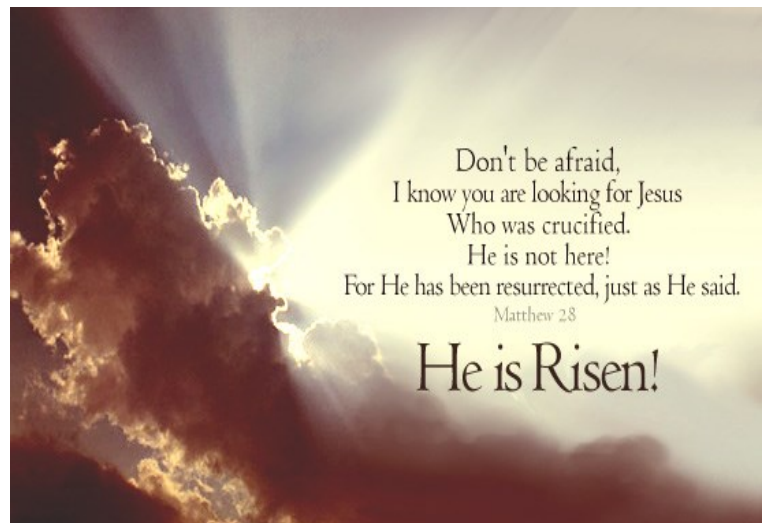
From Our Principal Mr. Rucker:
