Scrip News

We are now able to offer the following cards through Shop with Scrip: Discover (\$100) and Visa (\$50). Like American Express, both of these cards DO NOT have an activation fee. These will only be ordered if a family places an order. We will have a small supply of American Express cards in the office; however, families need to order those online before obtaining them in the office. The Visa Card has a short shelf life. It has an expiration date on it which is six months from activation. Since it is activated by the supplier when it is purchased from Visa, the expiration date will be less than six months when received by the family. If there is a balance left after the expiration date, the cardholder needs to contact Visa and get a new one issued for the remaining balance less a \$5.95 service charge. If not used prior to the six months, a \$3/month maintenance fee is charged.

We have also added Dutch Brothers, Noodles & Company, Cabos (Granite Bay) and Domenick's (Granite Bay) to scrip that is available to purchase.

This Friday is the last day to meet your scrip requirement for the 2014-2015 school year.
