Dear Holy Family Community,

We are nearing one of our major events in the annual Crab Feed. Some of you might wonder – *what's the big deal?*

The Crab Feed is an important event for our school because it raises a significant amount of money. The goal this year is to clear \$10,000 in proceeds from the event, and everyone in our school can play a part. Ideally, we would love to have everyone attend the event, as this is the best way to generate revenue. We have gone so far as to add a child care option for the evening to help make your attendance that much easier! Ultimately, you won't find a better night out that includes dinner and entertainment for \$45.

If you are unable to attend the event, you can still help the event be a success by donating Scrip to the event to aid the silent auction that evening. You can also purchase some of the Raffle Tickets being sold for \$10 each in limited supply. We will be raffling off a vacation in Tahoe (doesn't that sound great right now?!?!).
