## Principal News

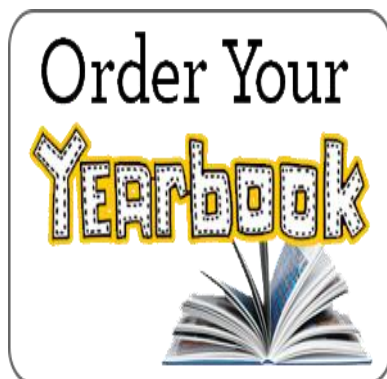
Dear Holy Family Community,
