Our Mission

Charter Career Prep provides 7-12th grade students with the vocational, academic, and social skills necessary to seamlessly transition to a successful career or a post high school education or training opportunity. State subject area standards are integrated with vocational and life skills to make learning relevant, applicable, and enjoyable. We help prepare students for the real world of employment through hands-on projects and the development of student leadership. To ensure student success, multiple levels of support and training are provided, including targeted academic remediation, individualized learning plans, and academic and career counseling.

Overview

Charter Career Prep provides an ideal choice for students seeking to pursue a vocational career path while earning their middle and high school diplomas. The program is fully accredited by the Schools Commission of the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC). Our classes are designed to engage students rather than rely on rote memory or seat-work. Our curriculum, experiences, projects, and guest speakers challenge our students to reason through ideas and form intelligent opin-

ions and answers. Our curriculum helps students develop good communication and problem solving skills. Many students come to our program because they feel lost in a large comprehensive middle or high school program. The small campus provides a safe and supportive environment and classes are generally small. This allows teachers to build positive relationships with students, helping to meet individual needs and ensuring immediate and ongoing communication with parents.

Charter Career Prep focuses on helping students gain responsibility, to learn what is required to get and keep a job, and to make informed choices for post-secondary education and life.

Program Highlights:

Charter Alternative Programs is chartered by the El Dorado County Office of Education. We established the first County Office of Education charter school in the state of California and remain pioneers in the area of charter education.

Partnerships with Folsom Lake College, the Regional Occupation Programs (ROP), and other community organizations strengthen our ability to prepare students for college and vocational opportunities. We serve students from Kindergarten through Adult Education.
