### Adult Education Learning Format

The El Dorado County Office of Education, Adult Education Programs, offers two distinct modes of learning.

**Distance Learning:** These courses are designed for students who cannot attend regularly scheduled classes. Students meet with an instructor to check out workbooks or DVDs at their appropriate learning level. The students then meet once a week with an instructor to review their progress and determine their ability to advance to the next unit.

**Classroom Format:** This is a more traditional school setting. Most classes include students that are working at various learning abilities, therefore, instructors may offer individual or group instruction to assist them in meeting their personal learning goals.
