The Charter Extended Day Middle School program was developed to provide a high quality after school program for students in 6th - 8th grade on their school campus. The Charter Extended Day Middle School program provides high-quality after school care options that are engaging for students and affordable for families. Partnerships with local school districts strengthen our ability to provide families with quality child care options across the county.

Charter Extended Day is part of the El Dorado County Office of Education Charter Alternative Programs, which is comprised of several unique programs tailored to meet a wide variety of student and family needs.



The Charter Extended Day Middle School program ensures consistent quality by providing Extended Day staff with curriculum planning in-services, audiovisual materials, project ideas, and ongoing safety/health workshops. All site programs are carefully planned to provide your family with affordable, safe, and excellent care.

**Program Eligibility**

Enrollment is available to all 6-8<sup>th</sup> grade students enrolled in an El Dorado County public school district, provided the program can meet the needs of the student. Priority is given to families needing daily care, Monday through Friday.

**Hours of Operation**

The Charter Extended Day Middle School program operates generally between the hours of 2:00 - 6:00 p.m.,

Monday through Friday. Depending upon client need, sufficient interest, and instructor availability, the hours of operation may vary by site.

Service may be available to middle school students at Extended Day elementary school programs for intersession, summer, holidays, and staff development days. Extended Day rates and minimums will apply.
