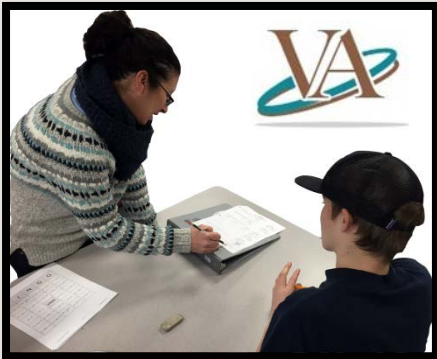

WHO WE ARE

Imagine traditional education with a teacher standing in front of 35 students. The teacher delivers a lesson to the entire class at the same pace. There isn't time to break the lesson down for each individual student's learning style and needs. No matter what your strengths or weaknesses, you get the same lesson as everyone else.



Now imagine a classroom where every student has a device. The teacher has pre-loaded the day's lesson on the computer. Students come to class already having seen the lesson in advance. They are now engaging the lesson at their pace, not the pace of a class. The teacher is free to roam the room and work with individuals as opposed to classes. When the work is graded, it is done online so parents and students receive instant feedback, can track progress or review content as needed. This is the core of the Virtual Academy!

EARLY COLLEGE PROGRAM



As partners with Folsom Lake College's Advanced Education Program, Virtual Academy students have the opportunity to complete ten or more college courses upon graduation.

Students receive both transferable college credit and weighted high school credit for each course they complete.

Virtual Academy students receive ongoing guidance and assistance in their college planning from counselors and transition specialists from FLC.
