

## CUPrep and CCA 2018 State Testing Schedule

Our schedules will be modified to accommodate the mandatory State Testing for two weeks. Since many students at CCA and CUPrep take classes with the other program, we will have one testing schedule which will accommodate both.

All students in 7, 8, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade will take a Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium (SBAC) computer adaptive test in Math and English. They will also complete two "Performance Tasks"; one in Math and one in English. The Performance Tasks will ask students integrate concepts in order to give a well thought out explanation of how to accomplish the task, solve the problem, explain the idea, etc.

Students in 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade will be taking the California Science Test (CAST). This test is going through revisions and scores will not be published. It will be given on Tuesday, April 10 for CCA 10<sup>th</sup> grade students and on Wed, April 11<sup>th</sup> for CUPrep 10<sup>th</sup> and both CCA and CUPrep 12<sup>th</sup> grade students. Independent study 12<sup>th</sup> grade students will be scheduled for this test by their supervising teacher.

Please check the schedule carefully and plan on arriving on time to your classes and tests. We will not be able to supervise students who are not scheduled for tests who arrive early on testing days.

Other Things to note:

- If a student misses one or more of the tests, he/she can make it up by coming in on the next day we have testing.
- Portions of the tests will require students to listen on headphones. We encourage you to bring your own ear buds.
- 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will also take a one hour science test in their regular science class.
- Students who are on independent study contracts and not taking regular classes will be taking the required tests as scheduled by their independent study teacher.
- Testing begins at 8:15, which is earlier than our normal schedule. The last two tests are shorter, so students do not need to arrive as early on 4/18 and 4/19.
