

To prepare for 10th grade

As we go through the next several months, there are some decisions and processes to consider. This semester is the time to:

1. Track your credits. You (the student) need to be in charge of what you take. It is your future. Complete the high school graduation requirements and college prep (UC) worksheets from the school website.
2. Get help if you are having difficulty in any of your classes. Don't be satisfied with less than your best. You can do as well as you desire and we will do everything we can to help you. We strongly suggest working with friends, seeking help from teachers, and/or getting a tutor. Do "whatever it takes" to learn and be successful in your classes.
3. Plan your next couple of years in High School. Generally, by the end of your sophomore year you are well on your way if you have completed at least 60 credits including:

1. Adv. English 1 **and** Adv. English 2
2. Algebra 1 and Geometry or Algebra 2
3. Biology
4. One to two years of a foreign language
5. World History
6. Health
7. Two years of P.E.
8. Possibly, A year of a fine art (Art 1, Drama, Photography, Art History, Taiko Ensemble, Technical Theater)
