

¡Hola Chicos y bienvenidos a la clase de español!

- Learning a second language requires practice, practice, practice!
- In order to take Spanish in the fall, you are required to memorize the following vocabulary
 - greeting people in Spanish;
 - Saying goodbyes
 - Identifying yourself and others
 - Identifying where one is from
 - Using courtesy expressions.
- The entrance test will take place the first day of school.

Assignment

- **Materials**
 - 3x5 Flash cards cut in half
 - Pair of scissors
 - Handout with pictures and conversations (provided)
 - Handout with vocabulary (Provided)
 - Glue stick
- **What to do**
 - Take the scissors and cut the pictures and conversations
 - On one side of the 3x5 flash card glue the picture and on the other side glue its corresponding conversation
 - **ATTENTION!** Cut one picture and its corresponding conversation at a time. Be careful not to scramble them or you will get confused.
 - **SUGGESTION:** Print two copies. One master copy to check your work with and one copy to work with.
- **How to do it**
 - **To memorize the vocabulary and the conversations**
 - Refer to the vocabulary handout to figure out what all words in the conversations mean
 - Memorize one conversation at a time and then move into the next one.
 - Attached are a few YouTube videos to aid with pronunciation and memorization
 - Watch them several times! Remember practice, practice, practice!
 - Each one is about 4 to 6 minutes long. Watch one at a time.
 - Recruit your parents, siblings, and/or friends to help you practice the vocabulary and the conversations.
 - Have them show you the picture and you repeat the conversation
 - Have them give you the Spanish expression and you say it in English
 - Have them give you the English expression and you say it in Spanish
 - Practice the conversations with your family
 - Once you have memorized a conversation, teach it to your family and/or friends.
