Charter College & Career Prep

An Alternative Path to Success

Charter College & Career Prep (CCP) serves students who may need an alternative setting to a traditional school, or who are experiencing difficulty meeting behavioral, social, academic, and/or attendance standards. We create individual learning plans focused on student goals, which include academic counseling, grade remediation, and post-secondary options. Our full-day schedule provides strategic instruction, enhanced support and supervision, and school-to-home communication.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Students interested in high-demand career opportunities, may benefit from the CCP program, which provides the vocational, academic, and social skills necessary to seamlessly transition to a successful career or a post high school training opportunity. We integrate state standards to make learning relevant, applicable, and enjoyable.

Many students are more successful in bodily kinesthetic learning activities that develop the skills necessary to be successful in the workplace. CCP classes actively engage students rather than rely on lecture based, rote memory, or seatwork. Current career-based classes include Robotics, Culinary Arts, MakerSpace, a Wilderness Outdoor class, and a Drone program. CCP also offers sociology and Leadership opportunities.

WORK READY CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

CCP offers a unique *Work Ready Certificate Program* emphasizing career readiness and the development of skills necessary to be successful in the workplace or to pursue post high school training or college. Students participate in a variety of specialized, real-life activities as part of the program, including career planning & preparation.

ADVANCED EDUCATION PROGRAM

CCP provides an *Advanced Education Program* (AEP) offered in partnership with the Folsom Lake College El Dorado Center. This program allows students to take community college courses during high school, while concurrently earning college and high school credit.

The tuition-free AEP provides the opportunity for many first-generation college graduates to participate and succeed in earning a certificate or diploma. The program focuses on helping students succeed in life through direct college experience and success, regardless of previous challenges.

The El Dorado Center college faculty and the CCP staff work together to provide a built-in support system for potential and participating students. The team includes an Outreach Specialist from Folsom Lake College, who meets with students regularly to develop individualized plans and ensure the students are successful. At CCP, we believe a college education is attainable for every student.

ACTIVITIES

The students at CCP stay active through our recreation classes, which includes a well-received basketball team. The teamwork, leadership, and strategy our students learn by training and having fun are put to good use when the students play community-based organizations such as the sheriff or probation departments.

REGIONAL OCCUPATIONAL PROGRAM

Students have the opportunity to participate in local *Regional Occupational Programs* (ROP). These programs involve partnerships created with our local college, high schools, and businesses, so that students can learn specific work skills while continuing their education.

CHARTER ALTERNATIVE PROGRAMS

CCP is part of *Charter Alternative Programs*, overseen by the El Dorado County Office of Education, is comprised of several unique programs designed to meet a variety of educational, emotional, and social needs of students from Kindergarten through Adult Education. Charter Alternative Programs also offers an Extended Day childcare program in partnership with our local Districts. Our programs are fully accredited through the Schools Commission of the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).
